NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES: \$29.00 for the first entry of each dog/each trial and \$21.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in the **same trial**. (Includes \$3.00 event service fee per entry and \$.50 AKC recording fee on first entry).

RALLY ENTRY FEES: \$29.00 first entry of each dog/each trial, and \$21.00 for second entry of the same dog in the **same trial**. (Includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee per entry)

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT SIGNATURE AND FEES. Entries not on an official entry form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules as on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are **UNACCEPTABLE**.

MAIL ENTRIES AND FEES TO: Janet Nash, Trial Secretary, 661 Westfield St, Saginaw, MI 48602. Entries sent overnight or express mail or other similar services should be designated **"NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED"**.

MAKE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: TCDDTC (Tri Cities Dog Training Club). **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST MAKE FEES PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS.** Returned checks will not be considered as valid entries. **\$25.00 NSF fee will be charged!** **POST-DATED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made. However, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms or whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors/cancellations of entries after the published closing day.

ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE along with identification, a judging program and directions to the trial site. Should acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, notify the trial secretary at 989-793-8606 or email * jhnash01@gmail.com.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, is disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of civil disturbances, riots, fire, Acts of God, or other circumstances beyond the control of the management, it is not possible to open or complete the trial, **NO** refund shall be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON. All but \$10 per entry (handling fee) will be returned. **MUST** provide Vet proof before trials start to secretary.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING. **NO** practicing will be allowed in the rings at any time. Dogs that are not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

THE MANAGEMENT WILL EXERCISE EVERY PRECAUTION FOR THE SAFETY OF DOGS exhibited, but it is understood that neither the Officers nor Tri Cities Dog Training Club will be responsible for the loss of nor any other damage caused by or to any dog from **ANY CAUSE**.

CRATING: There is limited space for inside crating. X-pens are not permitted. Please bring a floor covering to place under crates. Dogs must be quiet while crated or will be asked to leave the building. Thank you for your cooperation.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse the entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of the entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES JUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BUYLAWs, RULES, REGULATION, PUBLISHED POLICES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purpose, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. cocker spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color.). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired). Collies (rough, smooth). Bull Terriers (colored, white). Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy spaniels (King Charles and Rudy Bienheim and Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records have completed the requirements of a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify for particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
